Dress Code

Members are requested not only to adhere to the dress code themselves but also to ensure the dress code of other members/guests on the course and in the clubhouse complies with the code.

Individuals must be smartly dressed both on and off the course.

On the Course	In the Clubhouse
Golf Shoes must be worn.	Minimum dress code is to be smart casual at all times.
Shirts must have collars or round necks and be tucked in. Ladies shirts designed to be worn outside shorts are acceptable	Golf shoes are permitted only in the spike bar (which now incorporates the sports bar).
Tailored shorts and trousers only.	Footwear must be worn at all times
No combat style shorts or trousers or beachwear	Tailored shirts may be worn outside trousers.
	Hats, visors and trainers are not permitted at any time.
No denim, tracksuits, or vests. No football or baseball style shirts.	Tracksuits and vests are not acceptable at any time. Football and baseball style shirts are also prohibited.
Socks of predominantly one colour (preferably white) must be worn when wearing shorts.	Combat shorts or trousers are not permitted.
	Smart blue denim (i.e. no slits or holes) is now permitted downstairs in the clubhouse.
	Open toed sandals are permitted without socks but plastic flip flops are not permitted in the Clubhouse.
Please Note:	Please Note:
Changing clothes or footwear in the car park is FORBIDDEN	Jacket and tie to be worn in the dining room after 7pm at formal events.
Golfers must not share clubs or bags	Tailored shorts are not permitted in the Lounge Bar after 7pm on Wednesdays and Fridays
Mobile phones for emergency use only	The dress and behaviour of young children is the responsibility of their parents.
	Mobile phones are to be on silent in the Clubhouse. Owners of phones ringing in the clubhouse will be asked to turn their ring tones off and make a donation to the Captains charity

Failure to adhere to the dress code on the course may result in you being asked to leave the course unless the infringement is rectified and in the clubhouse you will not be served at the bar and may be asked to leave.
